First Woman Solo to the North Pole

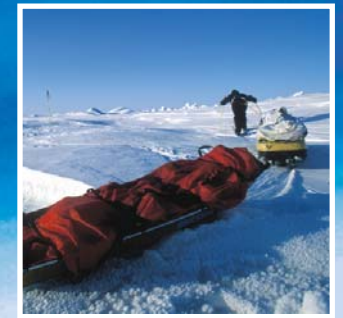
